

Seeking an Agreement on a Plan for Emissions Reductions at Navajo Generating Station

Goal

To achieve a widely-accepted agreement among the many parties having an interest in the reduction of emissions from the Navajo Generating Station (NGS). This agreement is expected to serve as a foundational document for a Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) determination by USEPA and as a basis for other potential actions by plant owners, public agencies and interested parties.

Scope

Nitrogen oxides, particulate matter, and hazardous air pollutant emissions from NGS Units 1, 2, & 3

General Schedule

Nov. 9 – Dec. 31	Identify and contact all potentially interested parties (EPA’s list of 50 + others as identified e.g., Bureau of Indian Affairs, Peabody Energy, City of Page) Determine level of interest of each identified party as “participating”, “tracking” or “informed” Solicit opinions of parties about preferred: <ul style="list-style-type: none">•preferred form of facilitated discussions;•preferred communications procedures;•sensitivity•other Identify “conditions” for participation, if any
Jan. 1 – Feb. 28	Facilitated discussions, negotiations and agreement First meeting of parties January 6-7 in Phoenix area
March 1 – 31	Outreach to all interests and USEPA

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
